- 5. Dog Control- More education around Animal safety and care...Education around the weather and pets..Will try to find an animal educator and an animal control officer.
- 6. Elders Trip-booked and taken care of- The Band will provide more funds to SHS for the elders that went on the trip and will compensate those Elders with a travel subsidy for their own trips...
- 7. Water Usage Water levels have been well-monitored and so far no issues for the potable water. The creek levels have been low below the WTP and Highways has been told to STOP filling up their tanks at the beaver pond.
- 8. Community Safety- Will install a couple of Trail Cams by the Moola Dike.
- 9. Attendance at Meetings- should be in person where possible. Wifi is not reliable here in the community and it is often very disruptive to the meeting when time is wasted trying to connect individuals. Also, individuals need to confirm their attendance so the right amount of food is prepared and nothing is wasted.
- 10.Housing Inspections- Have one councillor present each time- Have a scheduled time for all units, as outlined in the GGC Housing policy.
- 11.SDC/C & C combined meetings- will run the meetings together starting in September and all C & C will be a part of the meetings. SDC member at large will leave after the SDC business is concluded.
